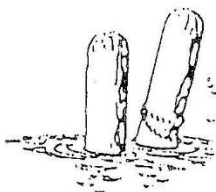
- Established contact with lake county water resources
- Discussed the health of the Keys Channels
- Discussed companies that may be able to assist us. One of those was Water Works of Windsor.
- Discussed the high toxins found in the Blue Heron Channel this year
- Discussed the Superfund site and its stability

11/16/2020 Update on items researching and conference call with Arie of Water Works.

- Ari describe their services and knowledge of water and channel issues
- Ari agreed to come out and tour the channels to get a better idea on what the channels are dealing with before he could offer any recommendations.

12/1/2020 In person touring of Channels and Harvester tour.

- Arie toured the channels and discussed Water Works options
- Harvester meeting included Arie, with discussion on whether the county will be issuing permits to utilize the Harvester to clean our channels.
- There is a meeting set up with Angela, Arie, and Fish & Game on December 14, 2020
- After that meeting Arie will then be able to send over proposals on how Water Works can help us.
- The decision was made to pull the Harvester out of the channel using a crane.
- Once out of the water an assessment will be done regarding repairs to the get up and functional.

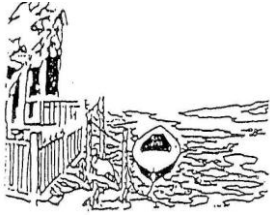

12/4/2020 Discussion with Lakeport Lagoons regarding their maintenance of their Lagoons.

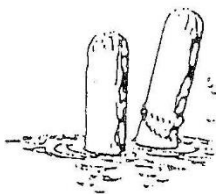
- They did not have a permit last year due to hydrilla
- They were told they would be getting a permit for 2021
- They also have issues with silt and have not addressed it because of cost and what to do with the silt once removed.

12/11/20 Letter to Alix Tyler regarding the Superfund site of usage of our silt if we dredge.

- The response indicated that the composition of silt is not dense enough and due to being a product of the Lake would not be a good match for the site
- The question is being directed to her manager just to make sure.

12/14/2020 Rich from Daniel Steel did an onsite inspection of the Harvester and discussed removal from the channel. The conclusion from him was their company does have a Crane that will remove it from the Channel. After removal it will be put on our trailer and repairs assessed. Next step would be approval by the POA Board.

12/16/2020 Crane utilized to remove Harvester from channel and place on trailer.
