### March

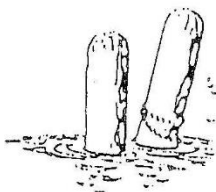
- The channel committee and Harvester operators reviewed purchasing quotes of a new harvester. The consensus was to fix the current Harvester.

- Andrew and Dana meet with the Spray boat operators. They reviewed the status of the boats and the operators. Discussion of training new operators.

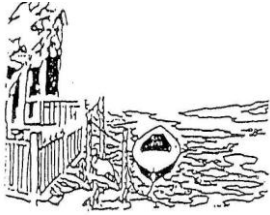
### May

- Met with Angela from water resources and the people from tribal eco restoration. We looked at and discussed the weeds and recommendations for removing the primrose. The Eco-restoration people are interested in after removal of the primrose to plant native plants in the channels. The eco-restoration people have not dealt with primrose. They will first work with the county in the area of Clarks Island. They recommend that we move forward with removal of weeds and silt in the Stubbs Channel and Marina Channel.

## Preserving the Keys

### June

- Received permit for aquatic plant removal by hand. This permit is good for all property owners in the Keys.
- The area of the leak on the Harvester is welded

### July

- Permit sent to county for removal of aquatic plants silt from the Stubbs and Marina channels.
- Soil samples taken in the Stubbs and Marina channels. The samples will be analyzed at a lab in Ukiah.

### August

- Leonard's Hauling did a trial in the Marina channels and cut the weeds.

### September

- Received funds from POA to cut the weeds in Marina and Stubbs channels
- Received signed permit from the county to move ahead with weed removal and silt.
